Prizes must be claimed the day of the show(s). None will be mailed. Unclaimed prizes will become property of the club which offered said prize.

### **RV PARKING INFORMATION**

- RVs may arrive on the grounds to park after 12:00 Noon on Thursday, May 21, 2026.
- Pre-reserved RV Parking is \$65.00 per night per space. Reservations are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Priority is given to reservations for all (3) three nights - Thursday through Saturday, leaving Sunday.
- R.V. parking space after deadline or on site with no reservation will be charged \$75.00 per night. Please note that no arrivals after 10:00 P.M. will be allowed. Payments on site must be in cash.
- Overnight RV parking will be in assigned spaces and only one vehicle permitted per space. A tow unit with a trailer is considered one vehicle.
- RV sites are equipped with electricity and water; however, it is strongly suggested to arrive with the ability to be self-contained if necessary (Site Control, the Cluster and/or The Meadow Park cannot guarantee against power outages or water supply failures)
- No waste or gray water may be discharged onto the grounds. Violating this rule will result in a Event Committee Hearing and County/State Fine(s).
- If you wish to park next to a particular party, make a note in the space in the online reservation form. Site Control will do its best to accommodate your request but cannot guarantee a particular location.
- No cones or other means of saving space will be allowed unless directed by Site Control personnel.
- Overnight parking is a privilege and not a guarantee. No abusive or argumentative language will be permitted. Failure to follow the rules or direction of the Site Control Staff on duty or the Event Committee will cause the immediate forfeiture of all parking privileges without refund of fees paid. As agent for the Cluster clubs, Site Control has full authority over parking decisions.
- Parking is strictly at the exhibitor's own risk. The Meadow Event Park/Virginia Farm Bureau, the Cluster Clubs, their officers, agents, members or Site Control are not responsible for loss by fire, theft, damage or loss of personal property or injury whatsoever.
- It is understood that there is no handicapped RV parking.
- RVs remaining on site Sunday, May 24th will be required to pay The Meadow Event Park for parking at its current daily rate.

### **PRIME PARKING INFORMATION**

Reserved parking adjacent to the main building is available to any exhibitor with a standard-size box truck, van or passenger vehicle. Handicapped parking is available.

- No Trailers or Motor Homes will be permitted in this parking area.
- Parking spaces are limited in number and are approximately 20' x 20' in size.
- If you wish to have adjoining spaces, make a note in the online reservation form. Site Control will do its best to accommodate your request but cannot guarantee a particular location.
- Fee \$75.00 for all (3) Three Days **with** Electricity.
- Fee \$50.00 for all (3) Three Days **with NO** electricity.
- Reservations for Prime Parking with or without electricity will only be accepted for the entire cluster (all three days). Fees on site will be \$100.00 with electricity and \$75.00 without. We highly recommend that you take advantage of the lower rate and reserve your parking now. Payments on site must be in cash.
- Please note electricity hookups requires a converter from 30 amp to 15 amp for your extension cord.

## **GROOMING SPACE INFORMATION**

- The building will be available to exhibitors no earlier than 3:00 P.M. on May 21, 2026, or at the discretion of the Show Chairman/Cluster Committee. Vendors and show personnel may set up earlier at the discretion of the Show Chairman/Cluster Committee. The building will close each night at 10:00 P.M., May 21 - 24, 2026.

***The B. O. B. Cluster has three types of grooming available to our exhibitors:***

### **DAY OF EVENT CRATING** Section (not for grooming)

No Charge. Very limited space. **NO ELECTRIC.**

Show Committee or Site Control may direct the placement of crates.

May require that crates be stacked and may limit chairs.

All dogs and equipment must be removed at the end of each day's show.

### **OPEN GROOMING** Section (grooming is allowed in this area)

No Charge. Very limited space. **NO ELECTRIC.**

Show committee or Site Control may direct the placement of crates.

May require that crates be stacked and may limit chairs.

All dogs must be removed at the end of each day's show.

Equipment may remain in the building each night yet must be removed within (1) one hour after Best in Show judging on Sunday, the 24th.

### **PRIME GROOMING** Section

Limited space. **ELECTRIC IS INCLUDED.**

**\$100.00 fee** for the Three-Day Cluster.

Must be reserved

Show committee or Site Control may direct the placement of crates.

Dogs may remain overnight in this section of the Grooming area with crate tags and a signed release form. Please note the building opening and closing times.

Equipment may remain in the building each night yet must be removed within (1) one hour after Best in Show judging on Sunday, the 24th.

- The building will be open on show days at 6:00 A.M. and closes at 10:00 P.M. daily.
- With limited space and power supply lines it is recommended that exhibitors reserve Prime Grooming.
- Prime Grooming includes a 10' x 10' space with one electrical outlet for \$100.00 for the (3) Three-Day Cluster. Exhibitors with reserved Prime Grooming are permitted to leave properly identified crated dogs in the building overnight. Security will be on-site, but a contact form with a waiver is required to leave dogs.
- Day Crating and Open (Non-Reserved) Grooming will be available on a first-come, first-served basis. Electric is not available in non-reserved grooming or day-crating. Furthermore, dogs are not to be left overnight in these sections of the Grooming Area. These areas will be inspected daily to ensure compliance with this rule.
- **ONLY** those exhibitors with reserved Prime Grooming are permitted to leave properly identified crated dogs in the building overnight.
- If you have a request for your grooming space please include it in the notes portion of the checkout page on the Site Control Website. Please understand this is a request, not a guarantee (example Breed, ring number or location, or near another exhibitor).

Failure to comply with the above rules and policies will result in an AKC Event Committee Hearing. The Meadow Event Park/Virginia Farm Bureau, The B.O.B. Cluster, the group clubs, their agents, officers and members, as well as Site Control, are not responsible for an exhibitor's inability to comply. Additionally, the previously listed parties remind exhibitors that they leave their dogs in the building at their own risk and are not responsible for loss by fire, theft, damage or loss of personal property or injury. Site Control, LLC, as agent for The B.O.B Cluster and Group clubs, has been delegated authority over matters listed above.

## SPECIAL MESSAGE TO EXHIBITORS & HANDLERS

Extreme Weather Conditions or CDC, State, Federal or Show site Guidelines may cause the Event Committees to cancel and/or modify the requirements at these events at any time. This is to ensure the health and safety of our dogs, judges and fanciers.

## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

Vehicle lights must be left on while loading and unloading.

Except for handicapped and official club business, motorized scooters will not be allowed in the building.

The kennel clubs are not responsible for the actions or products of the commercial vendors at these events.

We **highly** recommend that you do not leave dogs unattended in cars, exercise pens or motor homes; and we suggest that you secure your crates for the safety of your dogs.

No retractable/flexible leads allowed in the building.

No saving of parking, RV or grooming spaces.

Handlers & Exhibitors will be responsible for the actions of their dogs and maintaining control of their dogs.

Bathing Stations will be available outside.

For the safety of all guests, participants and dogs, children must always be under the direct control and supervision of their parents or an accompanying adult. Adults who fail to supervise children under their care properly may be subject to an Event Committee Hearing and/or asked to leave the event.

Baby strollers and four-wheel type carts used to transport children are not allowed in the building.

**THE CLUSTER RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REMOVE ANY ANIMAL OR PERSON IN DISTRESS FROM A PARKED VEHICLE, RV OR CRATE. ADDITIONALLY, PERSONS ATTENDING THESE DOG EVENTS HEREBY WAIVE ANY CLAIM FOR ANY AND ALL DAMAGES AGAINST THE CLUBS FOR SUCH REMOVAL.**

All Dogs must be removed no later than one hour after Best in Show on Sunday, May 24th.

Equipment may remain in designated areas of the building but may be shifted to allow for cleaning or for safety reasons. Building will open at approximately 3:00 P.M. on Thursday, May 21st, for general exhibitors at the discretion of the Cluster Committee.

Vendors and show personnel may set up earlier at the discretion of the Cluster Committee.

Doors are locked each night from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am.

Parking Fee: \$5.00 per car per day.

Crate identification labels and contact numbers are required for all crates in the building.

Ample trash cans & bins will be available in the show areas. Please help us keep the showgrounds and grooming areas clean. Exhibitors & handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their crates & vehicles.

No space for unentered dogs.

No overnight crated dogs except those in reserved Prime Grooming spaces with signed release form.

No private x-pens inside.

No soft-sided crates.

Ringside or aisle dolly-crating is limited to 15 minutes prior to scheduled ring time and removed directly following completion of breed and/or group judging.

Crates and other items in the Day Crating area must be removed each day immediately after completion of breed and/or group judging.

No shavings in private x-pens outside or on grounds without site control approval. A \$65.00 service charge will be added to checks returned due to insufficient funds.

No gasoline or diesel generators are permitted inside any building on the property.

**PHOTOGRAPHY NOTICE** - Only pre-contracted photographers, contracted vendors and the press may take photos for commercial use. If you are a commercial photographer and you have a pre-existing contract with a client, only photos of that client's exhibit may be taken. You may not freelance and post photos for sale of dogs and/or handlers without a pre-existing contract with the Cluster. NO exceptions! Private photos, not for resale, may be taken. This rule is in place out of fairness to the contracted photographers and vendors who have gone through the normal process to be part of these shows.

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

If at any time you need emergency services, please call 911 or the after-hours pet hospital first. Transportation to and from the hospital, urgent care centers, or veterinarian's office, as well as any charges for services, are the responsibility of the exhibitor and/or owner.

For Dogs and Bitches which have placed in a Licensed AKC Field Trial held by a Member AKC Club or Licensed Field Trial Club or for Dogs and Bitches which have earned an AKC Junior, Senior or Master Hunting Title.

### **Nederlandse Kooikerhondjes**

For Dogs and Bitches which have placed in a Licensed AKC Field Trial held by a Member AKC Club or Licensed Field Trial Club or for Dogs and Bitches which have earned an AKC Junior, Senior or Master Hunting Title.

Dogs and Bitches that have a Working Certificate (WC) or a Working Certificate Excellent (WCX) from the GRCA or an AKC Junior Hunter (JH) Title, Senior Hunter (SH) Title or Master Hunter (MH) Title.

### **Labrador Retrievers**

Dogs and Bitches who have been awarded a JH, SH or MH Title.

### **Nova Scotia Duck Tolling Retrievers**

An AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 per entry will be required for each dog entered at any 4 & Under 6 Months Puppy and Open Show.** All Recording and Event Service Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club. **(There is no Recording Fee or Event Service Fee for Junior Showmanship, Sweepstakes, Futurities, Brace/Team, Multi-Dog Classes or Special Attractions.)**

**No Entry** shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

**Entry Fees** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If because of riots, wars, strikes, civil disturbances, national emergencies, health emergencies, and the dictates of law enforcement or of the owner(s) of the grounds and/or facilities or other acts beyond the control of the management, it is impossible to open or to complete the event, no refund of entry fee will be made. Extreme weather conditions, such as, but not limited to snow storms, hurricanes, lightning, extreme heat, heavy rains, or other circumstances including, but not limited to, the condition of the facilities or grounds and/or the ingress and egress from the grounds, must be considered for the health and safety of the dogs, exhibitors and spectators. The well-being of dogs, exhibitors and spectators is of paramount importance and, in the event it is necessary to cancel or stop the event before completion, no refund of entry fee will be made. **No Refund for Duplicate Entries.** Every effort to find all duplicate entries will be made; however, if entry has been processed, no refund will be made. **An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be charged or withheld from refunds for duplicate entries.**

**An Administrative Fee of \$5.00 will be withheld** from all refunds for entries cancelled prior to the closing of entries.

**Errors on Entry Blanks.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**Each Owner and Agent** listed on the entry form and/or individual responsible for the dog at a show is bound by the Certification and Agreement on the front and back of the entry form regardless of who may have completed & submitted the entry form.

**As specified in Chapter 12, Section 4** of the AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, information contained on the entry form is required to be published in the club's show catalog. This information is also subject to publication in other media.

**Dogs May Arrive** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.**

**Judges Will Not Wait for Any Dog Holding Up a Class.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged.

**All Dogs Present** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

**Class Cash Prizes** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the Superintendent's Office advised at once. The Superintendent and Show-Giving Club disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**No gasoline or diesel generators** are permitted inside any building or within 100 feet of any tent in which this dog show is conducted.
